2) Introductions

Corinne Moog, Becky Vanden Heuvel, and Kelly Helstern joined this evening's meeting.

3) Executive Board Reports

a) Secretary's Report (Erin Hope)

• Motioned to waive reading of September 2023 meeting minutes, 2nd by Angie. Motion approved.

b) Vice President's Report (Stephanie Clehouse)

- Storm Chaser assembly on Friday. All assembly budget has now been used because this assembly was broken up into two sessions.
- Meeting with Student Appreciation committee next Tuesday
- 4 trees are being donated to be put near the playground side. Will be using money from Garden and Grounds budget to remove 2 dead trees near front and replace with maples.

c) Treasurer's Report (Angie Bennett/Jessica Wick)

 \$2,605 profit from Mums sale (up from last year); high credit card processing fees from Mum sales

- Read-A-Thon: currently spent \$2,922.65 in prizes (including fall cupcakes for kick off).
 Currently at 80% of goal; we need to make sure we have at least enough money to cover our budget for this school year.
- \$280.60 from Spirit Wear sales
- \$44.95 spent by 5th grade for Dot Day
- \$191.29 made from Mod Pizza fundraiser
- Playground update: met with Head of Facilities for Kaneland, Mark. We will need School Board approval and architect review for safety for any playground updates. He will provide information from the manufacturer that we already use, Cunningham. Hoping for possible Spring Break or summer install (all depends on what we choose as there are some long lag times.) What we replace does not need to be "equal" to other Kaneland schools but must be "equitable." Will look into grants and possible corporate donations.

d) Communication Report (Shannon Carreiro)

• October Knight Out (Portillo's) and Fall Fest flyer coming out shortly.

e) Fundraising Report (Amber Failor)

Suggestions for Mum fundraiser next year: Have phone numbers on order sheets to
contact people easily. Send out a mass email with pick up information. Try to have set
pick up times put out ahead of time with a TBD date. Have a sign up for more parent
volunteers.

4) Principal's Report (Courtney Ward)

- PTO will do Sign Up Genius for school store volunteers (once a month during WIN time on Fridays- usually last Friday of the month.)

 parties soon so that new members can start shadowing in January.
- There will be strict requirements on what is required of new Fun Lunch committee members.
